School Wardrobe Policy 2021-2022

At San Gabriel Christian School we agree that dress and grooming should be characterized by neatness, modesty, and moderation. The goal of one's wardrobe is to be clean, neat, modest, and God-honoring.

Wardrobe Guidelines for All Students

- Solid color polo shirt, turtle neck, or dress shirt
- Navy blue or khaki (tan) pants and shorts. Girls can also wear skirts, skorts or jumpers
 - Middle School students can wear black bottom (no jeans)
- Closed-toe shoe or closed-toe sandal with backstrap
- Outerwear (coats, sweatshirts, & jackets) may be any color or pattern
 - Suggestive or inappropriate writing, slogans, pictures, emblems, logos, etc. that are contrary to God's Word or a Christian lifestyle are not permitted

Students must:

- Dress in conformance with their biological sex
- Maintain neat, clean hair within natural hair colors, and boys' hair must be above collar, with no pony tails, or extreme hairstyles
- Wear socks, and girls can also wear tights
- Ensure shorts, skirts, jumpers & skorts are at least 2" below fingertip length

Students must not:

- Wear faded or torn clothing
- Wear leggings as pants, athletic pants, jeans or sweatpants
- Wear hats, caps or beanies (see office for exemptions)
- Wear sweatshirt hoods in class
- Wear excessively oversized clothes

Keep in Mind

- Jewelry, if worn, must be simple and in good taste. Earrings or other body piercing for boys are not allowed. Dangling or hoop earrings should not be worn for safety reasons
- Tattoos are discouraged and visible tattoos are not allowed

- Girls must wear shorts under skirts/jumpers (elementary only). Leggings may be worn under skirts/skorts/jumpers only
- Skirts/jumpers must be loose-fitting enough to provide modesty when sitting, walking up stairs, or casual activity
- Make-up may be worn by *middle school girls only*, as long as it is simple, in good taste, and not excessive

Spirit Friday

On Fridays students can wear Bulldog shirts/sweatshirts with free dress bottoms (pants/shorts/skirts).

Free Dress Days

The last school day of each month will be a free dress day. Other special free dress days will be announced throughout the year. The goal of one's wardrobe is to be clean, neat, modest, and God-honoring.

Policy Adherence

It will be the responsibility of the principal, administrative staff and teachers to monitor adherence to the wardrobe policy. Final judgment regarding a student's dress will be at the discretion of the school administration at all times. We ask each of our parents to help us in monitoring their child's clothing choices.

If the dress code does not adequately address issues that may arise, the administration reserves the right to make decisions that are in the best interest of all students and in keeping with the ideals of San Gabriel Christian School.

Students who choose not to comply with these wardrobe and grooming policies will be required to call their parents for a change of clothing. Non-compliance will result in disciplinary action.
